I am pleased to present the moveDC Plan which sets a transportation course in the District for the next twenty-five years. The plan details a vision and a set of implementable investments and policies to build a system that meets the needs of residents, commuters and visitors in a world class city by creating a sustainable, safe, and efficient transportation network.

Over the past four years, the District has grown by almost fifty thousand people and we project this trend will continue into the future. moveDC lays out a proactive and comprehensive approach to ensuring this growth will benefit all parts of the District, no matter how people choose to get around. The plan strengthens connections between neighborhoods while addressing congestion downtown. We envision building a 21<sup>st</sup> Century transportation system including:

- A high capacity transit system that grows our first streetcar line into a system serving the entire District;
- 200 miles of on-street bike lanes and off-street multi-use trails;
- Elimination of sidewalk gaps and making pedestrian safety improvements at intersections;
- A State of Good Repair on the District's roads, bridges, and tunnels; and
- Expansion of the regional rail network to meet the region's growing demands.

I would like to thank the members of the Transportation Plan Advisory Committee who helped shape the moveDC Plan, the staff of the many District and regional agencies who have given their time and energy, and the Federal Highway Administration for their assistance with the planning process. I also want to thank all of the DDOT staff who worked tirelessly to develop the moveDC Plan and will continue to be at the forefront of implementation.

Above all, though, the moveDC Plan is the product of the hard work of thousands of citizens, residents, and visitors to the District of Columbia, and I cannot thank them enough for helping to shape the future of the city.

The moveDC vision will take years of hard work and dedication to realize but we will work toward the vision, in partnership with the community and on a project by project basis to build a future for the District that we and the next generations of Washingtonians can enjoy.
